

## **Coffman Reacts to Pelosi Pronouncement on Health Care Votes**

*Believes Real Reform Still Possible*

**(Washington, D.C.)** – Rep. Mike Coffman (R-CO) issued the following statement after House Speaker Nancy Pelosi announced today that she does not have the votes to push the Senate health care bill through the House:

“Speaker Pelosi’s pronouncement today that House Democrats don’t support the Senate version of the health care bill, and that it won’t be voted on, is good news for the American people. If the President and Nancy Pelosi are finally ready to genuinely engage Republicans and start over on the negotiating process, we’re ready and willing.”
