H.J. Res. 1 prohibits outlays for a fiscal year (except those for repayment of debt principal) from exceeding total receipts for that fiscal year (except those derived from borrowing) unless

Congress, by a three-fifths roll call vote of each chamber, authorizes a specific excess of outlays over receipts. The measure would also require a three-fifths roll call vote of each chamber to increase the public debt limit.
