

Coffman Statement on Short-Term Continuing Resolution

(WASHINGTON) – U. S. Rep. Mike Coffman (R-Aurora) released the following statement today in response to the passage of H.J. Res. 48, a short-term continuing resolution that funds government through April 8 and reduces spending by another \$6 billion, bringing the total to \$10 billion in budget cuts over the last five weeks:

“We’ve avoided a government shutdown and delivered \$10 billion in spending cuts through stopgap funding bills,” Coffman said. “President Obama and his congressional allies need to work with us to get a responsible budget passed for the rest of this year.”
