

Coffman a Proud 'No' Vote on Clean Debt Limit Increase

(WASHINGTON) – U.S. Rep. Mike Coffman (R-CO) issued the following statement today rejecting a measure that would increase the nation's debt limit by \$2.4 trillion, granting President Obama's request for a "clean" debt ceiling increase without substantial spending cuts and meaningful entitlement reforms.

"I'm a proud 'no' vote on raising the debt ceiling without having a clear path out of this mess," Coffman said. "I can only hope that by decisively defeating the President's call for adding to our nation's debt burden that he can be forced to accept deep reductions in spending that must also include reforming our exploding entitlement programs."
