RULES:

The competition is open to senior high (grades 9-12) students from schools in the 6th Congressional District. Each school may submit a total of six entries, one entry per student. The Student artist must live in the 6th Congressional District.

Artwork must be:

- Two-dimensional,
- No larger than 28 x28" x 4"deep, when and if framed.
- Matted
- Cannot weigh more than15 lbs.

Within the following categories for acceptance for the show:

- Painting- oil, watercolor, acrylics, etc.
- Drawings- pencil, pen and ink, pastels, charcoal, crayon.
- Mixed media.

NOTE- No photographs, no collage, computer generated art.

EACH ENTRY MUST BE AN ORIGINAL CONCEPT: the entry may **not** reproduce an image from a third party's work in the same or any other medium; the work may not infringe the rights of any third party; the work may not violate the U.S. Copyright Laws.

All artwork must be matted for hanging. Please keep in mind matting can enhance or detract from the art so choose carefully.
